It was provisionally agreed to arrange a joint meeting with the Estate and revise the Parish Plan It was agreed this would entail much work on behalf of the Parish Council

## **11. Millennium Green.**

The only quotation regarding future maintenance of the Millennium Green was received from C. Ellis to the sum of £850.00. This quote was approved and it was agreed to pay the first instalment at the meeting in May (£425.00)

## **12. Clayton with Frickley Energy Park.**

Cllr. Mann commented that there had been no further action from West Coast Energy to report on as it appeared that delays were being encountered now that subsidies had ceased for wind turbines. Information from transmitting mast was being analysed

## **13. Recreational Field**

**Cllr. Burkinshaw** reported that she had received a quotation of £459.85 for the gates It was agreed to accept this quotation and to proceed with the installation
